

Italian machinery manufacturers meet demand for nonwovens

Over 90 Italian exhibitors are presenting at INDEX™23, including over 40 machinery manufacturers, said the Association of Italian Textile Machinery Manufacturers (ACIMIT).

According to the organisation, as in past editions, ITA (Italian Trade Agency), with support from ACIMIT, has organised an exhibition space reserved for companies manufacturing machinery for the sector.
