**Green Label** is a document that aims to identify and make easily understandable the energy and environmental performance of the textile machine.

In particular, the quality of equivalent emissions of carbon dioxide (Carbon Footprint - CFP) produced during operation is the parameter chosen to give a value to the eco-efficiency of the labelled machine and testifies to the sustainable commitment of the associate members taking part in the project.



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
