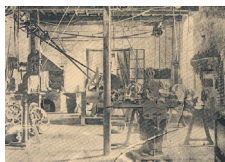
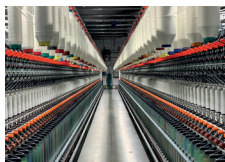
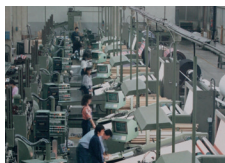

The estimated value of Italian production in 2024 is about **2.0 billion euro**.

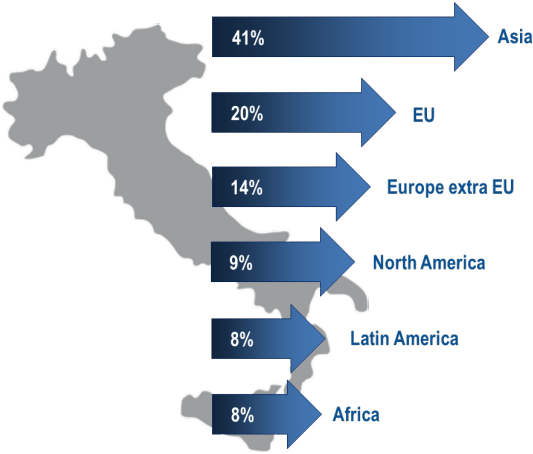

Italian textile machinery exports

86% of Italian total sales are realized in about 130 destination Countries. The process of internationalization and the vocation for innovation in the sector allowed Italian companies to consolidate and further improve the leading position of Italy in the world textile machinery industry.

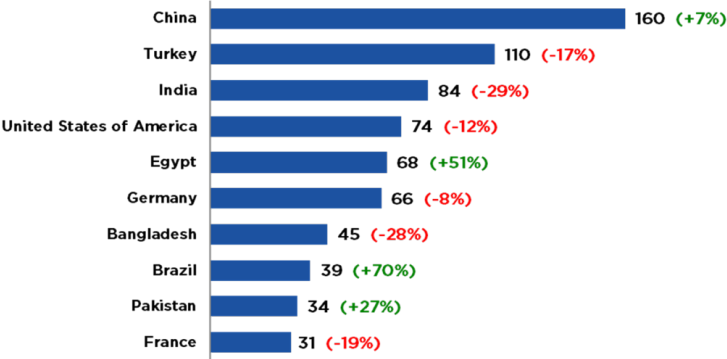
Italian textile machinery exports - geographical destination (Jan-Sept 2024)

In the first nine months of 2024 the main destination of Italian exports of textile machines was **Asia** (41%), followed by **European Union** (20%) and Europe extra EU (14%). The biggest contribution to the Italian exports of textile machinery came from **China**. Italian sales toward Chinese market amounted to a value of 160 million euro. Others main markets are **Turkey**, **India** and **United States of America**.

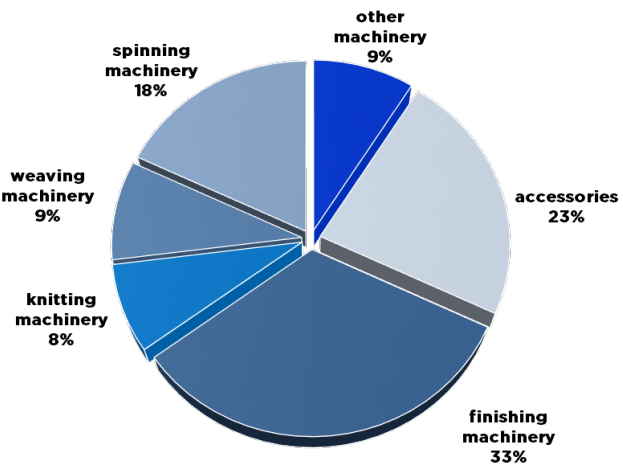
Italian textile machinery exports - main markets (Jan-Sept 2024)

% on total



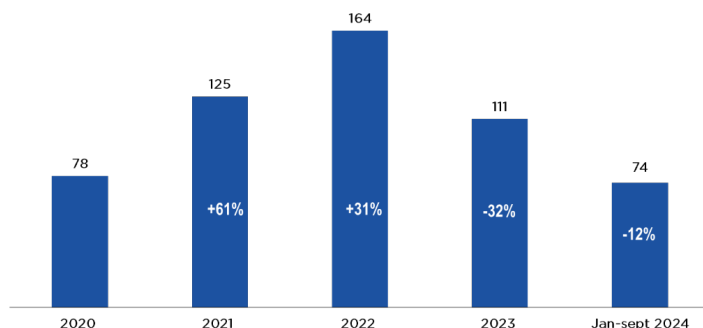

United States of America, strategic market for the Italian textile machinery

The textile sector in the United States is a broad and varied industry that includes the production of fibers, yarns, fabrics, and finished products such as technical textiles. Despite strong global competition, the US textile industry stands out for its innovation, automation, and the production of advanced.

It is precisely the high value-added US production that has strengthened collaboration with Italian textile machinery companies over the decades. US market is one of the top destination of the Italian export of textile machines, despite the current period of slowdown in investment that characterizes the U.S. textile sector. In 2023 period the value of Italian sales to US market was **111 million euro**, while in the 2024 Jan-Sept period the value reached **74 milion euro**.

Italian textile machinery exports to USA *million euro, y/y change*

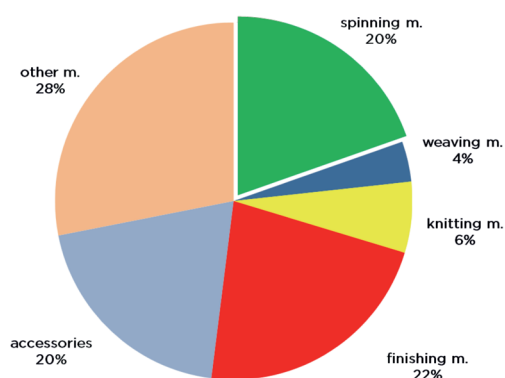

The most requested Italian machines were the other machines (28% of the total export towards United States of America) including machines for making ropes and cables and machines for the manufacture of felt and nonwovens, followed by finishing machines, (22%) accessories and spinning machines (20%).
