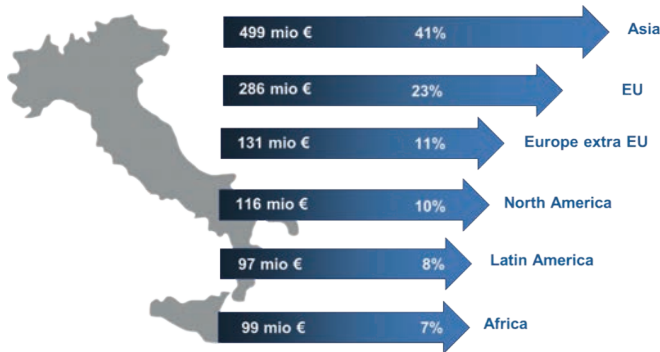

Italian textile machinery exports

86% of Italian total sales are realized in about 130 destination Countries. The process of internationalization and the vocation for innovation in the sector allowed Italian companies to strengthen the leading position of Italy in the world textile machinery industry.

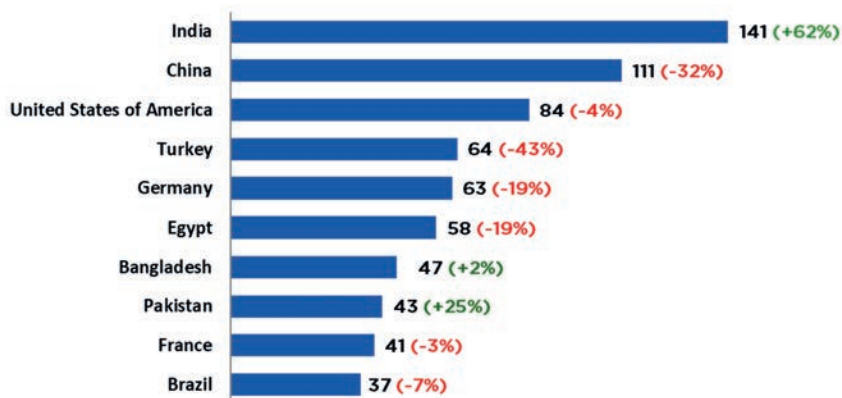
Italian textile machinery exports - geographical destination (Jan-Sept 2025)

In the third quarter of 2025 the main destination of Italian exports of textile machines was **Asia** (41%), followed by **European Union** (23%) and **Europe extra EU** (11%). The biggest contribution to the Italian exports of textile machinery came from **India**. Italian sales toward Indian market amounted to a value of 141 million euro. Others main markets are **China**, **United States of America** and **Turkey**.

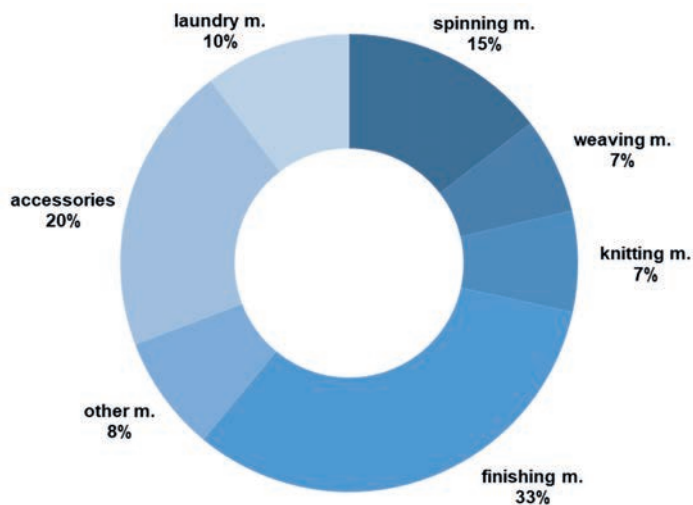
Italian textile machinery exports - main markets (Jan-Sept 2025)

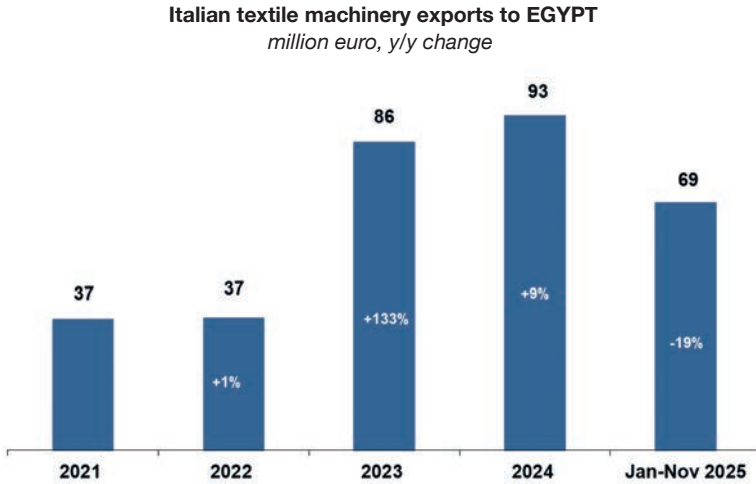

Egypt and Italy: good chances for cooperation in textile sector

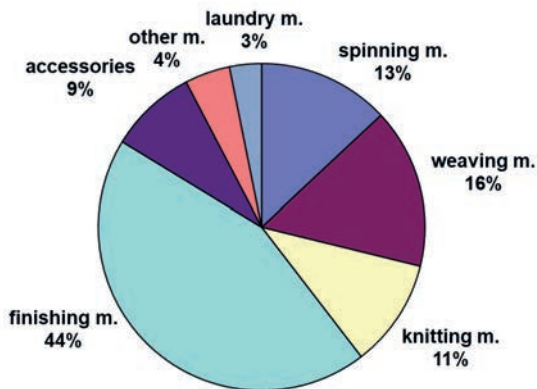
In the first eleven months of 2025 the Italian sales of textile machines to Egypt reached a value of 69 million Euro, confirming Egypt the first market for Italian textile machinery manufacturers in Africa.
