



Italian Textile Machinery Manufacturers Target Taiwan Market at TITAS 2026

ACIMIT highlights renewed Taiwanese demand and customised technology solutions ahead of the October textile machinery show

Italian textile machinery manufacturers will showcase their technologies at TITAS 2026 (Taiwan International Textile & Garment Machinery Show) in Taipei from 6 to 8 October 2026.

Italy's participation reflects its focus on its long-standing relationship with Taiwan's textile manufacturing sector, where companies have traditionally placed emphasis on quality and technological research.

Taiwanese Market Sees Renewed Demand

Taiwan's textile market is undergoing changes following a period of global adjustment. According to the information provided by ACIMIT, Italian textile machinery exports to Taiwan recorded a significant increase at the beginning of 2026, indicating renewed demand from the local textile industry.

Taiwanese manufacturers are seeking technology solutions to support production recovery and modernisation, with Italian machinery companies positioning their technologies around these requirements.

Spinning Machinery Remains a Key Area

Taiwan's textile production has historically been concentrated in the upstream stages of the supply chain. Within this segment, Italian spinning machinery continues to represent the largest share of local interest, alongside demand for finishing machinery and related accessories.

The demand reflects the requirements of Taiwanese manufacturers seeking to diversify production and develop higher value-added market segments.

Italian machinery manufacturers are highlighting their ability to adapt equipment to specific production requirements, with customisation and flexibility forming part of their approach to the Taiwanese market.

According to Marco Salvadè, President of ACIMIT, the increase in Taiwanese demand at the beginning of the year underlines the role of Italian machinery technologies in the market.
